<u>UPCOMING PROJECTS</u> March/April Update

The Washington State Department of Transportation Ferries Division, operating as Washington State Ferries, will seek bids / proposals for the following projects in the near future. M.V. ISSAQUAH DRYDOCKING CONTRACT NO. XE3497

The Contract work consists of the following repairs to the Issaquah class ferry M.V. Issaquah: USCG credit drydocking and internal structural exam, hull gauging, anode renewals, inspect the rudder and controllable pitch propeller blade, and overhauls to the rudder and hub. Shaft seal element renewals; fresh water wash, curtain plate interior and exterior spot coatings. Grit blasting and coating of the vessel hull, pilothouse visors, fan and generator room houses and stacks. Preservation of bilges and steering space. Repairs to the sprinkler, sewage, sea chest vent, and bilge piping. Other miscellaneous work and maintenance as required. Funding will be state only

M.V. CATHLAMET DRYDOCKING CONTRACT NO. TBD

The Contract work consists of the following repairs to the Issaquah class ferry M.V. Cathlamet: USCG credit drydocking and internal structural exam, hull gauging, anode renewals, inspect the rudder and controllable pitch propeller blade. Fresh water wash, curtain plate interior and exterior spot coatings. Grit blasting of the upper and lower vehicle deck and vehicle deck steel renewals. Preservation of machinery bilges, sewage, and water tank, firemain, sprinkler and sewage piping renewals. Refurbishment of passenger deck. Other miscellaneous work and maintenance as required. Funding will be state only.

SR 160 SOUTHWORTH FERRY TERMINAL TIMBER DECK & ROOF REPAIRS CONTRACT NO. TBD

This project work will remove the current timber decking with asphalt or concrete, and replace with a metal steel form and concrete. Additionally, the single ply membrane roof on the terminal building will also be replaced. Funding will be state only.
